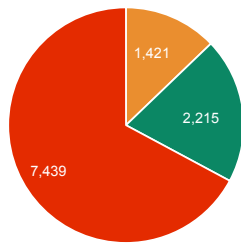

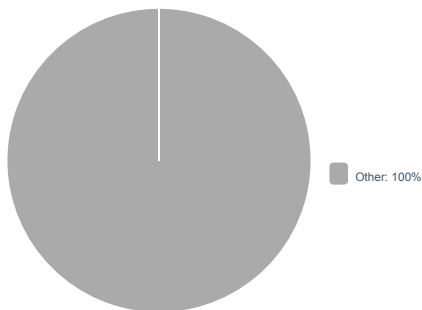

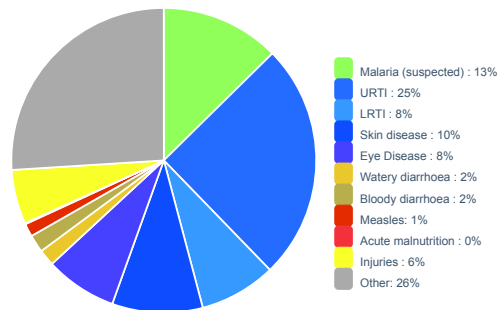
#### Crude Mortality (%)
